Call the combined Special and Regular Meetings of the Trustees of the Tulsa Airports Improvement Trust and the Members of the Tulsa Airport Authority to order.

- 1. Approve the Minutes of the combined July 13, 2023, meetings of TAIT and TAA.
- 2. Operating and Financial Reports.

Administrative, Finance, IT, and Operations Contract Action.

- 3. Approve Commission and Installation of Artwork with Shane Darwent in the amount of \$225,000.00 for the Terminal Area Suspended Artwork Project. TUL Contract F24-015.
- 4. Approve Master Services Agreement with AskReply, Inc., d/b/a B2Gnow in the amount of \$36,291.00 for software and implementation to support the administrative and reporting requirements of TAIT's disadvantaged business enterprise programs. B2Gnow is a sole source provider. TUL contract F24-022.
- 5. Accept Bid and Award Contract for Professional Services to Loomacres Wildlife Management, LLC, in the amount of \$61,777.78 for one year with four one year options, effective October 1, 2023. TUL Contract F24-014.

This contract provides wildlife services to both TUL and RVS.

- 6. Approve purchase of four passenger boarding bridge canopies from Hubner Component Solutions LLC, a sole source provider, for \$68,769.68. This is \$2,544.68 above the FY24 budgeted amount. TUL Contract F24-019.
- 7. Approve Gas Sales Agreement with Symmetry Energy Solutions, LLC, effective August 1, 2023 for one year, for purchase of natural gas for Tulsa International Airport. The price is equivalent to the current Inside Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (FERC) Gas Market Report for ONEOK, plus \$.2450/MMBtu. TUL Contract F24-016.

8. Approve purchase of new Juniper network switching equipment from CDW-Government, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$172,724.10. TUL Contract F24-023.

This purchase is for 30 network switches at a unit cost of \$5,757.47 to be deployed throughout the terminal. This is a budgeted operating capital purchase; the budgeted amount is \$175,000.

9. Approve purchase of Premium Cityworks Enterprise License and Service Support Agreement with Azteca Systems, LLC — Cityworks, a sole source provider, in the amount of \$85,000 for one-year, with two one-year renewals. TUL Contract F24-017.

This agreement is for a comprehensive airport work order system that will replace the current ASOCS and TME work order management system.

10. Accept selection and approve award of contract for Professional Consulting Services to Woolpert in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for the implementation of Azteca Systems, LLC – Cityworks software. TUL Contract F24-018.

This contract provides testing, training, pre and post deployment support, ArcGIS integration, mobility and dashboards, tracking and tenant chargebacks, common facility and grounds work orders and request, ARFF vehicle inspections, logbook tracking, Part 139 inspections, Part 139 work orders, and Part 139 day, night, and special inspections.

This Purchase Agreement provides for the purchase and installation of updated software/connections and new hardware (circuit monitoring devices, beacon control, and roaming in-field laptop to control ALCMS) and consolidating the communication of the ALCMS from the abandoned west vault to the newer east vault. This will also upgrade the graphics on the Airfield Lighting Control and Monitoring System to reflect the changing Taxiway configuration.
