11. Reject bids for the FAA ILS Cable Replacement Project pursuant to the Oklahoma Public Competitive Bidding Act, Okla. Stat. tit. 61 §119. The bidding documents have been repackaged and readvertised.

- 12. Approve award of Professional Services Agreement with Jacobs Engineering Group Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$77,367.00 for the Terminal Building Re-Roof Connector B-Side Project. TUL Contract F26-027.
- 13. Accept bid and approve award of contract to Coontz Roofing Inc., in the amount of \$1,474,500.00, for the Terminal Building Re-Roof Connector B-Side Project. TUL Contract F26-023.

This contract provides funding to remove and replace approximately 45,500 square feet of roofing on section M, E, F and G. TAIT received two bids. The engineer's estimate was \$3,000,000, 49% above the lowest responsible bidder.

14. Approve award of Professional Services Agreement with Huitt-Zollars, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$104,779.37 for the Perimeter Fence Replacement Project. TUL Contract F26-028.

This contract provides funding to perform construction administration services for the Project. The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise ("DBE") goal was 2.9% and the consultant has committed to utilizing 30.3%.

15. Accept bid and approve award of contract to Delta Specialty Contractors, LLC, in the amount of \$363,496.20 for the Perimeter Fence Replacement Project. TUL Contract F26-024.

This contract provides funding to remove and replace approximately 2,500 linear feet of 6' fence and replace it with 8' fencing. TAIT received three bids, one of which was non-responsive. The engineer's estimate was \$500,265.00, 37% above the lowest responsible bidder. The DBE goal was 2.2% and the contractor has committed to utilizing 3.3%
